

QRS 2024 MONTHLY ROSE SHOW SCHEDULE

National Rose Society of Australia Inc. Standards & Rules (2023) Are Applicable. Total Point Allocation for roses is 100 points, (replacing previous maximum 10 points).

PACKING MATERIALS: The packing material used to support a rose entry may be above the level of the container, but should be neat in appearance.

DECORATIVE HYBRID TEA ROSES: All Hybrid Tea Rose cultivars may be exhibited in any Hybrid Tea class. There are, however, **no points for form** in Decorative HT Rose classes, therefore high centres and perfect spiral petals are not judged in a decorative class.

<u>DIVISION A — EXHIBITION ROSES</u>

Class 1: 3 Roses, NND in separate containers

Class 2: 1 Red Rose

Class 3: 1 White/Cream Rose

Class 4: 1 Pink Rose Class 5: 1 Yellow Rose

Class 6: 1 Rose, any blend or colour

other than the above

Any HT may be entered as an Exhibition Rose, however, roses in this category are primarily judged on form and condition.

Form: 40 points Condition: 30 points Size: 20 points

Presentation, Stem & Foliage: 10 points.

<u>DIVISION B — NOVICE</u> (refer to note on p.2)

Class 7: 1 Stem Exhibition HT Rose

Class 8; 1 Stem/Cut HT Decorative HT Rose(s)

Class 9: 1 Stem/Cut Floribunda Rose(s)

Class 10: 1 Stem/Cut Mini-Flora or Miniature Rose(s)

Class 11: 1 Stem/Cut of any rose(s) not otherwise provided for in Novice Classes

All Exhibitors are Eligible for Rest of the Schedule

OPEN SECTION

Class 12: 1 Full Bloom

Class 13: 1 Perfumed Rose

Class 14: Multi-Stage Exhibit: 3 Stems H.T. Roses, 1 Cultivar, 3 Stages (bud to

full bloom), vertical arrangement, in 1 container

Class 15: 1 Stem/Cut Modern Shrub Rose(s), includes David Austin roses

Class 16: 1 Stem/Cut Old Fashioned or Heritage Rose(s)

Class 17: 1 Stem/Cut Polyantha Rose(s)

FLORIBUNDA ROSES

Class 18: 1 Stem or Cut Floribunda Rose(s)

Class 19: 3 Stems or Cuts of Floribunda Roses NND in one container

[Note: NND means Not Necessarily Distinct – i.e. 3 of the same Floribunda roses or 2 the same plus a different cultivar or 3 differently named Floribundas.]

DECORATIVE HYBRID TEA ROSES

Class 20: 1 Cut H.T. Rose(s) (multiple head), side buds allowed

Class 21: 1 H.T. Rose any colour

MINIFLORA ROSES

Class 22: 1 Stem Miniflora Rose Class 23: 1 Cut Miniflora Rose(s)

MINIATURE ROSES

Class 24: 1 Stem Miniature Rose Class 25: 1 Cut Miniature Rose NB: Any HT may be entered as a Decorative HT rose. However, roses in this category are <u>not</u> judged on form or size.

Condition - 40 points **Beauty** - 30 points

Stem & Foliage - 20 points

Presentation - 10 point

VASES

Class 26: 1 Vase of H.T. Roses NND, Frontal Presentation

Class 27: 1 Vase Floribunda Roses NND, All Round Presentation

Class 28: 1 Vase Miniature or Miniflora Roses NND, All Round Presentation

NOTES: Refer to the NRSA's new point allocation scale over the page.

Rough Guide

Exhibition HT Rose: This is a rose which displays good form, freshness, size, substance, brilliance and purity of colour, has <u>a high-pointed</u> <u>centre</u> and, at the time of judging, is at a stage of maximum beauty. The centre of the bloom should appear high and well defined and when viewed from above the outer petals of the bloom should display a circular outline. It must be staged with its own stem and foliage.

<u>Decorative HT Rose:</u> This is a rose which displays <u>petals</u> of good substance which are <u>gracefully arranged in its most decorative phase</u>. Form is not a criteria, although symmetry is important. It should be displayed with foliage and side buds are permitted.
